



California Proposition 65 Statement

California Drinking Water Protection and Toxic Substances Control Act (Proposition 65, 1986) California Proposition 65 requires clear and appropriate warnings on products that contain chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Some of the substances on the list managed by the OEHHA have established "safe harbor" limits, but not all. Therefore, this statement is independent of Safe Harbor values and only indicates whether or not a substance is included in the Proposition 65 list.

This declaration applies to the substance list version as of March 31, 2026.

Products sold by CTC may contain substances from California Proposition 65. Our piezo accelerometers, velocity sensors, and loop power sensors use a ceramic containing over 50% lead by volume. All sensors are hermetically sealed, and there is no significant consumer risk. However, please use this statement as a warning that CTC products may contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.
